If your employer is a member of the WSC Training Consortium, you are entitled to take as many classes per year as you wish for your \$100 annual fee. *This policy may be limited by your employer's policies.*

Please be aware that Department of Behavioral Health significantly limits the number of students who may enroll in some classes, as follows:

- Addiction Counseling Skills is limited to 8.
- Group Counseling Skills is limited to 12.
- Other classes are limited to 14 to 20. This may be reduced due to the limitations of the particular training space.
